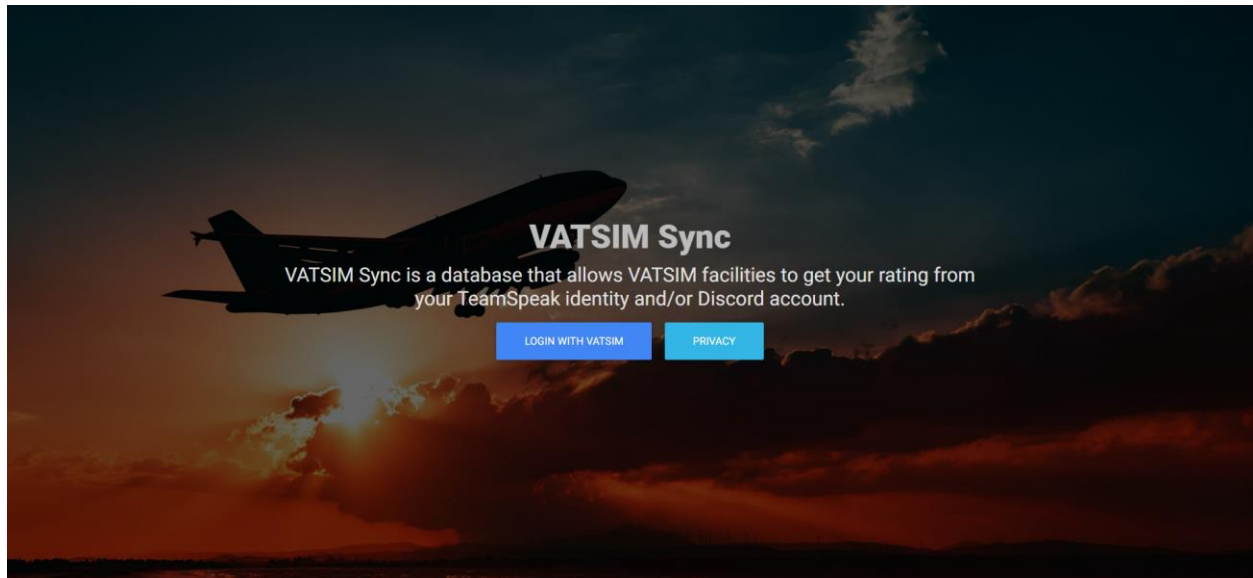


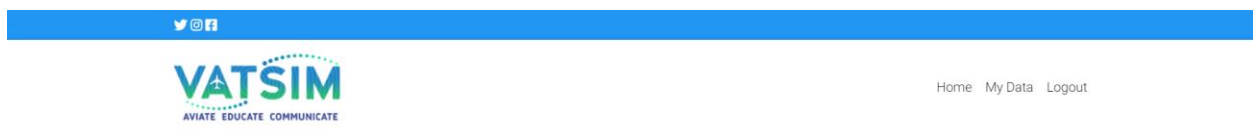
ZDC TeamSpeak and Discord Permission Setup Guide

Welcome to ZDC! ZDC uses both TeamSpeak 3 (TS) and Discord for communications. All permissions on both platforms are assigned by VATSYNC. In this guide, we will cover how to get permissions on both ZDC TeamSpeak and Discord server.

First of all, visit <https://vatsimsync.com/> and you will see this page:



Click on “Login with VATSIM” and proceed with your VATSIM credentials.

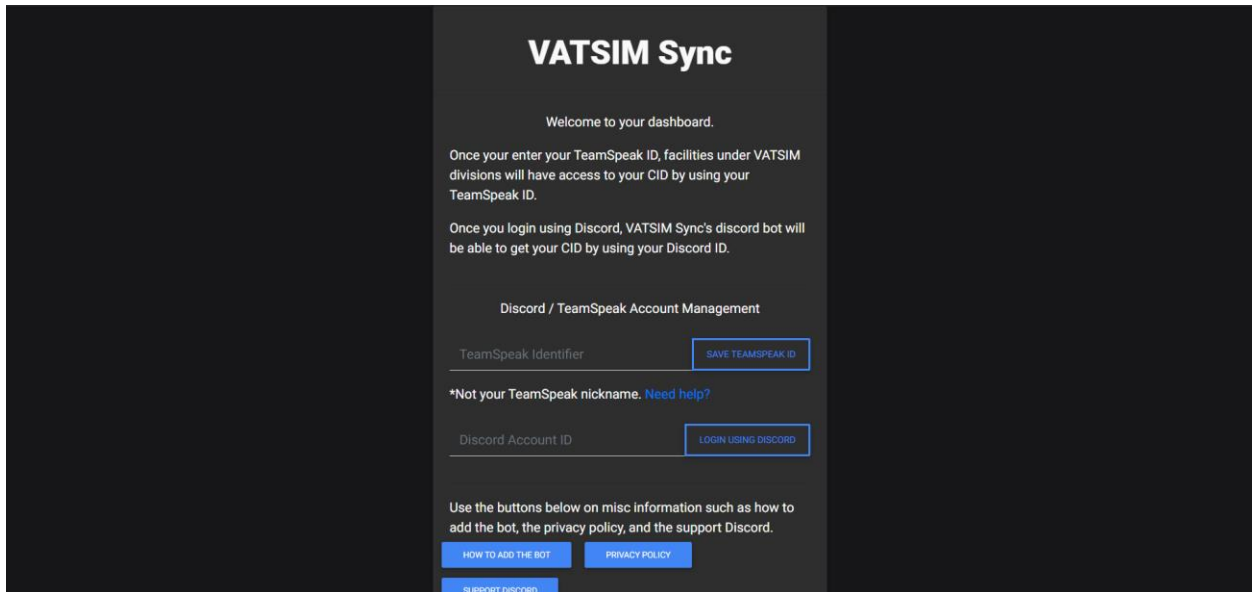

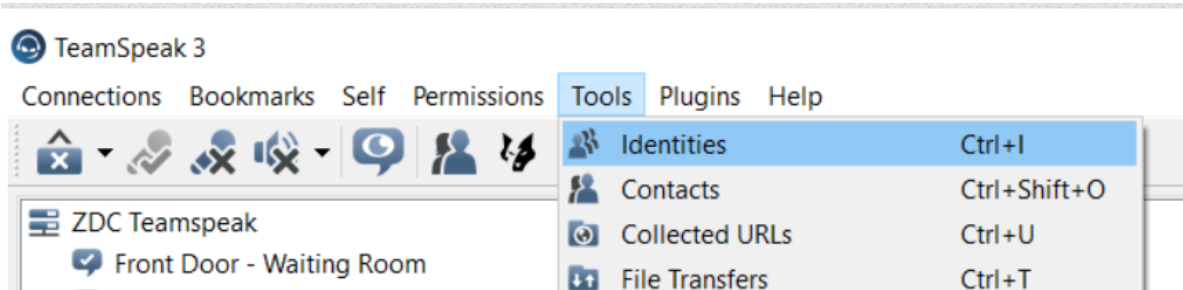

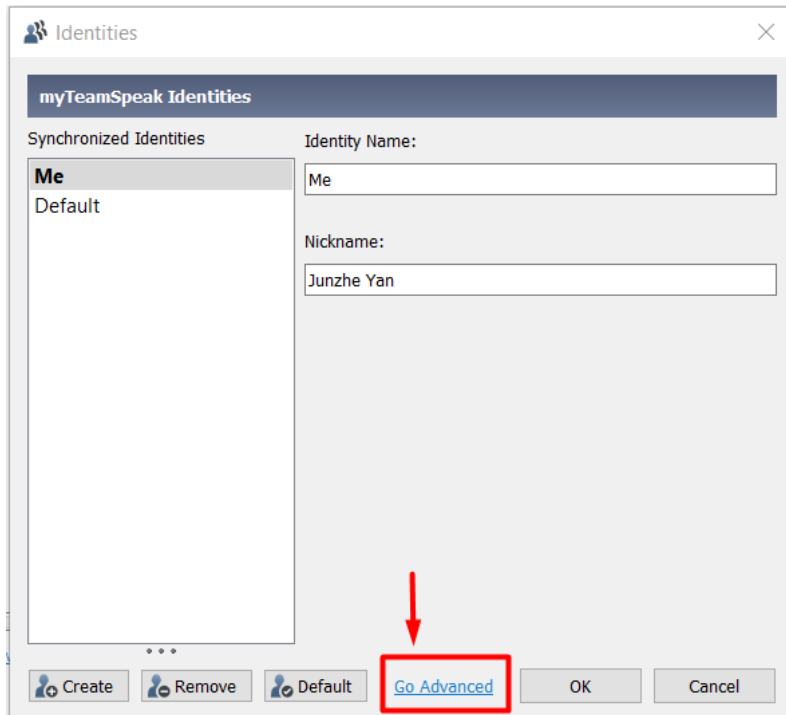


- TeamSpeak Permission Setup

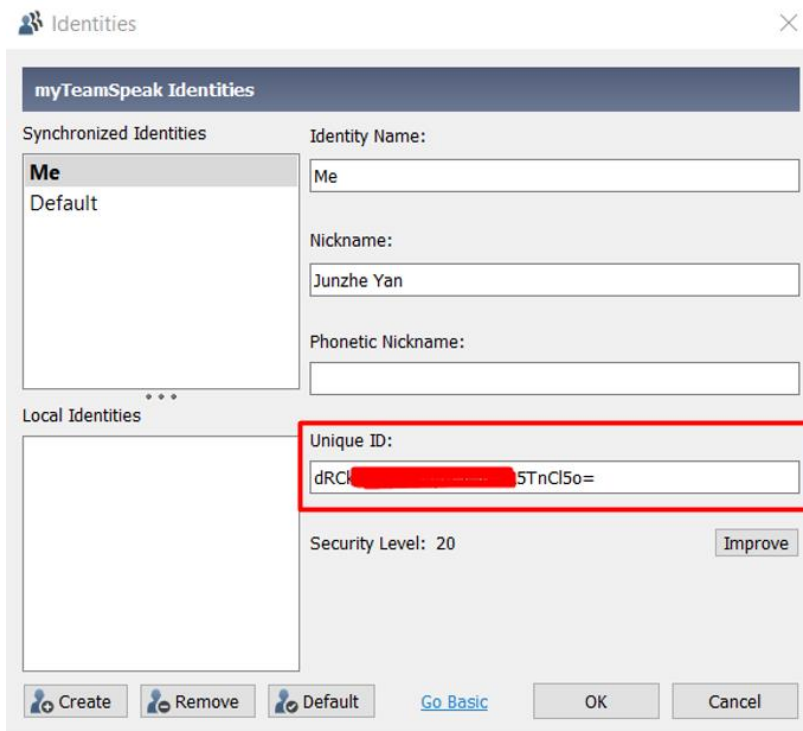
Open your TeamSpeak 3 Client. Go to Tools→Identities or hit Ctrl+I:



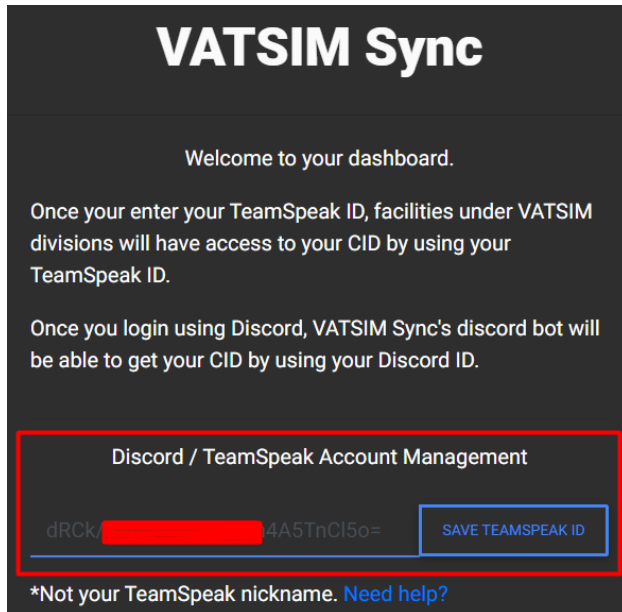
You will see the following window. Click “Go Advanced”:



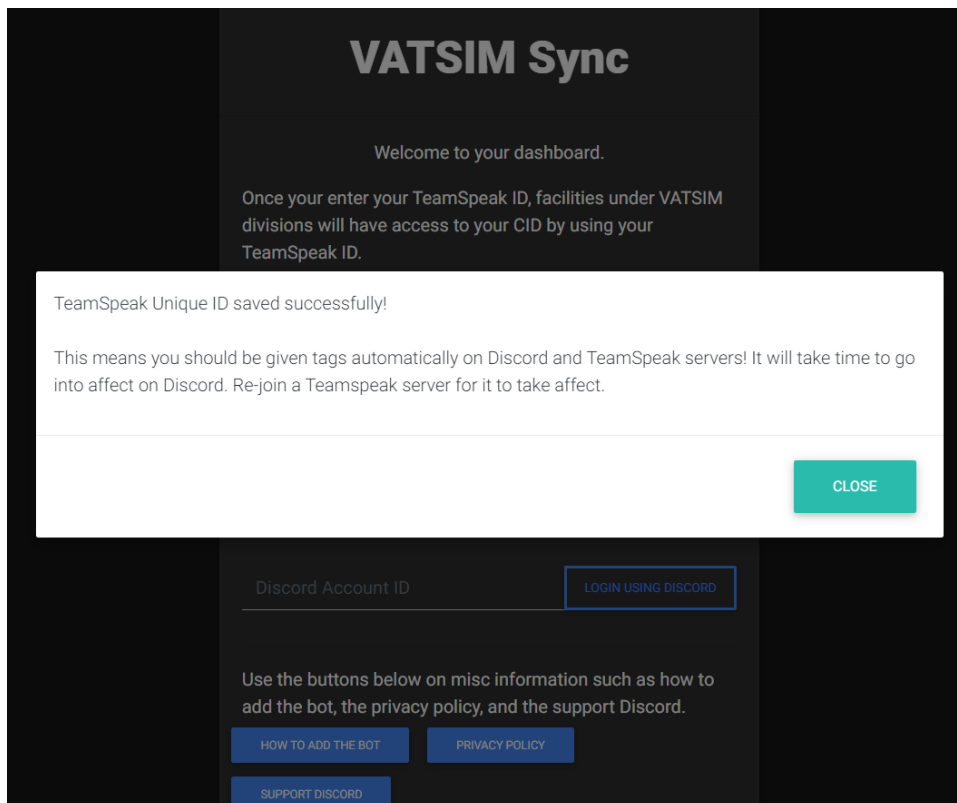
You should see some extra information which includes “Unique ID”:




Copy the whole Unique ID to your clipboard, and paste into VATSIM Sync website we opened earlier:



After you are done, click on "SAVE TEAMSPEAK ID", and you will see a popup window that suggests the process is completed:

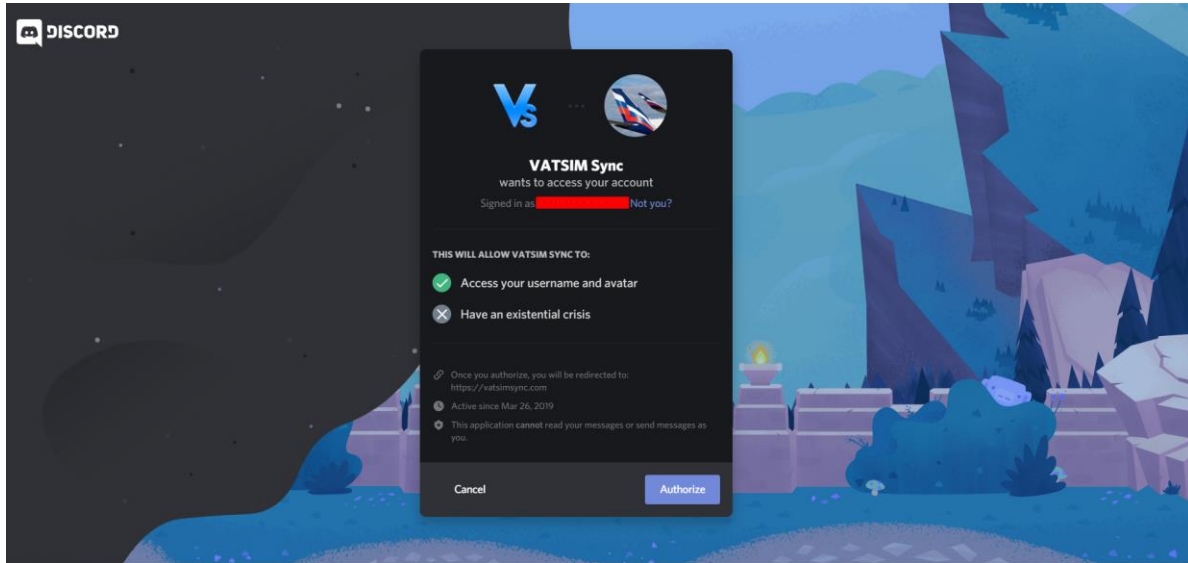


After closing the popup window, you should see instead of the “Save TeamSpeak ID” button, there should show a red button called “Unlink TeamSpeak ID” instead. At this point, you have successfully set up your TeamSpeak. Reconnect to the ZDC TeamSpeak server in order to let the bot assign you appropriate roles. This process may take a few minutes.

- Discord Permission Setup

Comparing to setting up the TS permissions, setting up Discord is much easier. Click on “Login Using Discord”, there will be a new window for you to authorize VATSIM Sync to link with your Discord account. Click “authorize” to proceed.



You should see a popup window to confirm your account has been linked. Close the window, you should also see a red “Unlink Discord” button. At this point, you should have permissions and corresponding controller ratings assigned on the ZDC Discord server.
